RULES FOR ENTRY

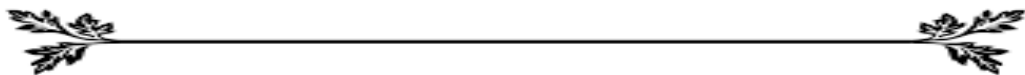
1. Adults: A fee of 50p for each item should be submitted with entry form. Childrens entries free.

SECTION ONE: FLOWERS

(Two entries permitted per class. Exhibits to be home grown)

1. A vase of perennials: five stems.
2. Best flower in your garden
3. Annual sweet peas: a vase of five stems
4. Any rose: a vase of three single blooms
5. An indoor pot plant.

Flower Arrangement *(garden or florist material)*

6. Five floating flowers
7. An arrangement in a tea pot.

SECTION TWO: HANDICRAFT

Two entries per class permitted: exhibitors unaided work

8. Knitted or crocheted hat, gloves or scarf
9. An item of handmade jewellery
10. Item made from reusing or recycled materials
11. Item made from wood or metal
12. Handmade ceramic item

SECTION THREE: PHOTOGRAPHY

(two entries permitted)

13. Family
Max. mounted size 12 x 10 inches (30 x 20 cm)

SECTION FOUR: COOKERY

*(One entry per class. Unaided work of the exhibitor: homemade, home baked.
Presented on a flat plate or board: sweet items with a doyley and savoury without.)*

14. Chocolate Cake – can be decorated
15. 5 pieces of Shortbread
16. Bara Brith made in a 1lb loaf tin
17. 3 Fruit Scones
18. Victoria Sponge Cake with Jam filling
19. Quiche

SECTION FIVE: STORE CUPBOARD

(One entry per class. Unaided work of the exhibitor. Jars and glasses should be clear glass, and free from commercial markings. Lids for jams should be metal or twist tops, plastic tops or cellophane covers. Lids for chutneys should be plastic lined twist tops or plastic tops, not cellophane. Presentation will be taken into account)

- 20. A jar of any flavour of curd.
- 21. A jar of soft fruit jam
- 22. A jar of any other type of jam
- 23. A jar of marmalade
- 24. A jar of chutney

SECTION SIX: GARDEN PRODUCE

(One entry per class: all to be grown by the exhibitor)

- 25. 5 tomatoes – any type
- 26. 3 beetroot – any type
- 27. 5 runner beans.
